Important instructions to all eligible candidates who have qualified in the NEET (UG)–2026 examination and aspire to seek admission to the BHMS Degree Programme are required to register online on the official website of the Ayush Admissions Central Counselling Committee (AACCC) of Ministry of Ayush, Government of India, New Delhi at <https://aacc.gov.in> in order to participate in the centralized online counseling process for the allotment of seats under Deemed-to-be Universities.

2) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Candidates must have qualified in **NEET UG-2026** by securing the prescribed minimum percentile below mentioned category:

B) Academic Qualification:

Candidates must have passed 10+2 / H.Sc. or an equivalent examination from a recognized board with subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology) or Biotechnology and English as per the National Commission for Homoeopathy regulations.

C) Age Limit:

Candidates should have completed 17 years of age at the time of admission on or before 31st December 2026.

3) FEE STRUCTURE

a) Tuition Fees

The students shall pay the prescribed tuition fee only for the 4½ years academic duration of the BHMS Degree programme. No tuition fee shall be payable for Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship (CRRI) training period.

- a) advised to report and complete the admission process strictly within the date and time specified in the “**Counselling Schedule**” issued by the **AACCC of Ministry of Ayush**.
- b) The candidates should report their original certificates along with the Tuition Fee & Other Fees as specified above through Demand Draft / NEFT / RTGS.

- c) i) Candidates without original certificates / documents shall not be allowed to take admission.
- ii) Candidates who have deposited their original documents with any other Institute / College / University and come for admission with a certificate stating that “their original certificates are deposited with the Institute / College / University” shall not be allowed to take admission in the allotted Medical College as directed by the AACCC of Ministry of Ayush, New Delhi.
- d) Candidates shall pay the Tuition Fee and Other Fees, as per the schedule prescribed by the University / Institution within the due date notified for subsequent years.
- e) Part payment of tuition fee and other fees are not permitted.
- f) No extension of time will be given for the payment of fees (or) the submission of original certificates under any circumstances
- g) At the time of admission, candidates and their parent / guardian should sign declaration / undertaking in Annexure declaring that they shall abide by the rules and regulations of the University including Anti-Ragging regulations of the UGC / NCH and observe good conduct and behavior and that they are bound by the University rules on payment of fees / refund of fees.
- h) If any candidate withdraws from the course of study in which he/she was admitted, after the expiry of the cut-off date prescribed for admission to that course of study or in midterm and the seat is rendered vacant, the first year fee paid will be forfeited and the student will also be required to remit the entire course fee for the remaining years of the course period.

5) EXAMINATIONS:

The students will be issued hall tickets for the University Examinations and permitted to appear for the examination only after the full fees is paid.

9) REFUND POLICY

The following refund policy shall strictly be implemented by the constituent colleges of Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation (Deemed to be University), Salem, Tamil Nadu.

TIME OF WITHDRAWAL	REFUND OF FEE
a) Any time after admission but during the counselling period (Where seat can be surrendered to AACCC of Ministry of Ayush and the same be re-allocated by AACCC of Ministry of Ayush).	Rs.25,000 will be deducted and remaining amount will be refunded within 14 working days.
b) Any time after counselling period (Where seat cannot be surrendered to AACCC of Ministry of Ayush and the same cannot be re-allocated by AACCC of Ministry of Ayush).	No refund will be provided. In addition, the candidate shall be required to remit the entire Programme fee for the remaining years of the Programme period.

- c) Request for cancellation of admission will not be entertained through E-mail / Telephone / Mobile etc.

- d) The refund amount will be processed within a maximum of 14 working days from the date of cancellation.

Please note that the University will strictly follow the AACCC of Ministry of Ayush timelines / guidelines w.r.t. resignation procedures. All the candidates are advised to refer the Counseling Bulletin / Circulars uploaded by the AACCC of Ministry of Ayush for the updates on resignation and timelines and applicable procedures for them.

10) IMPORTANT NOTE:

- a) Candidates are advised to regularly visit the Ayush Admissions Counselling Committee (AACCC) of Ministry of Ayush, Government of India website: www.aaccc.gov.in and the College website: www.vmhmc.edu.in for the latest updates, notifications and admission related information from time to time.
- b) The Provisional Allotment letter issued by the Ayush Admissions Counselling Committee (AACCC) of Ministry of Ayush is subject to the candidate fulfilling all the eligibility criteria prescribed by the National Commission for Homoeopathy (NCH), New Delhi including medical fitness. Candidates who do not satisfy the prescribed eligibility requirements or found medically unfit shall not be admitted to the programme to which they have been allotted. If, at any stage, it is found that a candidate has furnished false information, submitted forged or fabricated documents or suppressed any material information, his / her admission shall be cancelled without prior notice and appropriate action shall be initiated in accordance with the applicable rules and regulations.
- c) Students admitted to the University shall be governed by the Rules and Regulations of Vinayaka Mission's Research Foundation (Deemed to be University) including those relating to academic conduct, discipline, hostel administration, fee refund policy and Curbing the Menace of Ragging the UGC / NCH Regulations as amended from time to time.
