All India Entrance Examination – 2025 January Session PG Diploma in Early Intervention

Instructions to the Candidates

PG Diploma in Early Intervention Programme is offered at School of Rehabilitation and Behavioral Sciences, Puducherry.

1) Duration of the Programme: 1 Year

2) ELIGIBILITY FOR ENTRANCE EXAMINATION & PROGRAMME:

Candidates who have passed M.B.B.S./ BAMS /BHMS/ BUMS / BSMS / BNYS or Equivalent Degree, BOT / BPT / BASLP / B.Ed-SE / B.Sc Nursing/ Post Graduate in Psychology /Social Work / Special Education / Child Development or Equivalent Degree with 50% aggregate marks in the qualifying examinations.

3) FEE STRUCTURE: Annual Tuition fee is Rs. 45,000/- + University fees and other fees Rs.8000/-

4) ONLINE FILLING OF APPLICATION FORM:

- a) Application forms are available online only. It should be filled up carefully by the candidates with complete details and submitted online along with a scanned copy of Degree / Provisional Certificate, Degree Mark Sheet(s), Photograph & Signature as attachments.
- b) The Registration fee of **Rs.1,000/-**(Rupees One Thousand only) is to be paid while submitting online application, The fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- All the Entrance Examination related communications like Entrance Examination Results and Counseling Intimation letter etc., will be sent through Application Portal only. Hence, the candidates are advised to keep their application number for their future reference. No separate communication will be sent to any individual through e-mail or SMS.

5) HALL TICKET:

- a) Entrance Examination Hall Ticket can be downloaded by all eligible candidates from the Entrance Examination Portal of this University.
- b) HALL TICKET MUST BE PRODUCED BY THE CANDIDATES AT THE TIME OF ENTRANCE EXAMINATION CENTRE WITHOUT FAIL. NO CANDIDATE WILL BE ALLOWED TO WRITE THE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION WITHOUT THE HALL TICKET.
- c) Mere acceptance of a person as a candidate for writing the Entrance Examination shall not confer on him/her any right / eligibility for admission. The candidate who does not satisfy the prescribed eligibility criteria shall not be considered for admission.
- d) Candidates will not be allowed to carry any textual material, printed or written, bits

of papers or any prohibited materials such as Pen, Pencil, Calculator, Mobile Phone or any other Electronic Devices that are likely to be of unfair assistance inside the examination hall. The Pen, Pencil and eraser will be provided to the candidates at the examination hall.

- e) Candidates will be allowed to leave the examination hall at the end of the Examination only.
- f) Candidates shall maintain perfect silence and attend to their papers only. Any conversation or gesticulation or disturbance in the examination hall will be deemed as misbehavior. If any candidate is found to be misbehaving or using unfair means or resorting to impersonation, his/her candidature will be cancelled and he/she will be liable to be debarred from taking any Entrance Examination of the Deemed to be University.
- g) All candidates appearing for the All India Entrance Examination shall be required to sign an attendance.
- h) The OMR answer sheet of the candidates should be handed over to the invigilator along with the question booklet. If any candidate fails to do so, his / her candidature shall be cancelled.

6) MODE OF ENTRANCE EXAMINATION AND QUESTION PATTERN:

- a) The All India Entrance Examination will be conducted in ENGLISH only. The Examination duration is 2 Hrs. The question booklet will consist of 100 multiple choice questions (single best response)

 - 2. Communication disorders
 - 3. Disability acts for persons with communication disorders
 - 4. Team Management of children with multiple Disability
 - 5. Disability Act for persons with disabilities and schemes available
 - 6. Inclusive education for children with special needs
 - 7. Critical period for development
 - 8. Sensory motor integration
 - 9. Pre reading and writing skills for special children
 - 10. Different types of physiotherapy for cerebral palsy children
 - 11. Special approaches used in language development for deaf children
 - 12. Motor, cognition language, social, and emotional development of children in the critical period
 - 13. Perinatal and post-natal causes of children with Down syndrome, cerebral palsy
 - 14. Benefits of early intervention and treatment
 - 15. Different approaches used by physiotherapists for cerebral palsy children
- c) The candidates are advised to be at the Examination Centre an hour before the commencement of the Examination
- d) Allocation of marks: One mark per question, There shall be no negative marking for incorrect answers. No marks will be deducted for un attempted questions. All questions should be answered.

7) MODE OF SELECTION:

Selection made on the basis of the marks secured by the candidates in the Entrance Examination and merit based Counselling will be conducted by the Admission Monitoring Committee (AMC) of VMRF-DU. Results will be published in the University website **www.vmrfdu.edu.in**
