All India Entrance Examination – 2025 January Session For M.Phil (Clinical Psychology) Programme

Instructions to the Candidates

M.Phil (Clinical Psychology) Programme is offered by School of Allied Health Sciences, Department of Audiology and Speech Language Pathology, Vinayaka Missions Medical College & Hospital Campus, Karaikal

1) Duration of the Programme: 2 Years

2) ELIGIBILITY FOR ENTRANCE EXAMINATION & PROGRAMME:

Candidates with M.A. / M.Sc. Degree in Psychology from a university recognized by the UGC with a minimum of 55% marks in aggregate. For SC/ST category, a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate is essential.

3) FEE STRUCTURE: Annual Tuition Fee Rs. 3,00,000/-

4) ONLINE FILLING OF APPLICATION FORM:

- a) Application forms are available online only. It should be filled up carefully by the candidates with complete details and submitted online along with a scanned copy of Degree / Provisional Certificate, Degree Mark Sheet(s), Photograph & Signature as attachments.
- b) The Registration fee of **Rs.1,000/**-(Rupees One Thousand only) paid while submitting online application, will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- c) All Entrance Examination related communications like (Entrance Examination Results and Counseling Intimation letter etc.,) will be sent through Application Portal only. Hence the candidates are advised to keep their application number for their future reference. No separate communication will be sent to any individual e-mail or SMS.

5) HALL TICKET:

- a) Entrance Examination Hall Ticket can be downloaded by all eligible candidates from the Entrance Examination Portal of this University.
- b) HALL TICKET MUST BE PRODUCED BY THE CANDIDATES AT THE TIME OF ENTRANCE EXAMINATION CENTRE WITHOUT FAIL. NO CANDIDATE WILL BE ALLOWED TO WRITE THE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION WITHOUT THE HALL TICKET.
- c) Mere acceptance of a person as a candidate for writing the Entrance Examination shall not confer on him /her any right / eligibility for admission. The candidate who does not satisfy the prescribed eligibility criteria shall not be considered for admission.

- d) Candidates **will not be allowed** to carry any textual material, printed or written, bits of papers or any prohibited materials such as Pen, Pencil, Calculator, Mobile Phone or any other Electronic Devices that are likely to be of unfair assistance inside the examination hall.
- e) Candidates will not be allowed to leave the examination hall till completion of Examination.
- f) Candidates shall maintain perfect silence and attend to their papers only. Any conversation or gesticulation or disturbance in the examination hall will be deemed as misbehavior. If any candidate is found to be misbehaving or using unfair means or resorting to impersonation, his/her candidature will be cancelled and he/she will be liable to be debarred from taking any Entrance Examination of the Deemed to be University.
- g) All candidates appearing for the All India Entrance Examination shall be required to sign an attendance.
- h) The OMR answer sheet of the candidate should be handed over to the invigilator along with the question booklet. If any candidate fails to do so, his/her candidature shall be cancelled.

6) ENTRANCE EXAMINATION CENTRE:

The All India Entrance Examination will be conducted at School of Allied Health Sciences, Department of Audiology and Speech Language Pathology, Vinayaka Missions Medical College & Hospital Campus, Karaikal. The candidates have to appear for the Entrance Examination at their own expenses.

7) DURATION OF ENTRANCE EXAMINATION AND QUESTION PATTERN:

- a) The All India Entrance Examination will be conducted in ENGLISH only. The question booklet will consist of 100 multiple choice questions (single best response)
- b) Maximum marks will be 100 and the duration of the examination will be 2 hours.
- c) All questions must be answered and they carry equal marks. There will be no negative mark for wrong answers. Correct answer must be shared with Pencil in the OMR Answer Sheet supplied along with the question booklet.

d) Syllabus:

Social Psychology – Biological Psychology-Theories of Personality – Human Development-Motivation- Statistics and Research Methodology – Emotions, Stress and Coping – Psychological testing – Thinking and Intelligence -Abnormal Psychology – Attention and Perception-Psychotherapy and Counselling – Learning and Memory – General Psychology.

- e) The candidates are advised to be **at the Examination Hall 30 minutes** before the commencement of the Examination.
- f) The Candidates need not bring a Pencil, ball point pen. This will be provided to them at the Examination Hall.

8) MODE OF SELECTION:

Selection will be made on the basis of the marks secured by the candidates in the Entrance Examination and Interview marks put together. To qualify to be called for interview, a candidate must have secured not less than 50% marks (in case of SC/ST 40%) in the Entrance Examination. Only short listed candidates based on the marks secured by them in the Entrance Examination in the order of merit will be called for interview. Results will be published in the Notice Board and also in the University website **www.vmrfdu.edu.in**
