2) ELIGIBILITY FOR ENTRANCE EXAMINATION:

- a) Candidates who have passed the qualifying 12th Standard examination (10+2) / H.Sc. (or) its equivalent examination with Science subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology).
- b) Candidates who are appearing for HSC (+2) or its equivalent examinations in March / April 2025 are also eligible to appear for the Entrance Examination.
- c) Selection of candidates will be based on the merit of the entrance examination.

3) AGE LIMIT:

Candidates shall complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December 2025.

5) ONLINE FILLING OF APPLICATION FORM:

- a) Application forms are available online mode only. It should be filled up carefully by the candidates with complete details and submitted online along with scanned copy of Mark Sheet(s), Photograph & Signature as attachments
- b) The Registration fee of **Rs.1,000/-** (Rupees One Thousand Only) paid while submitting online application, it will not be refunded under any circumstances
- c) During online registration, all candidates, should upload the H.Sc. Mark Sheet(s) on or before 05.07.2025 .
- d) If any candidate does not upload a copy of the H.Sc. Mark Sheet(s) to the University his / her ranking will be fixed as specified in this prospectus.
- e) All theEntrance Examination related communications like Entrance Examination Hall Tickets, Results and Counseling Intimation letter etc., will be sent through Application Portal only. Hence, the candidates are advised to keep their application number for their future reference. No separate communication will be sent to any individual e-mail (or) SMS.
- f) Candidates are advised to visit our University website: www.vmrfdu.edu.in regularly for updates from the date of submission ofonline application till the end of the admission process without fail. VMRF (Deemed to be University) shall not be responsible for any consequences resulting due to non-diligent follow-up of notices, notification and publications appearing on the websites regarding the Entrance Examination for admission to B.Sc. Clinical Psychology (Hons.) Degree Programme for 2025-2026 session.
- g) Candidates who are unable to apply the online application through our University website, you can approach with your Parents (or) Guardian along with the all original certificates in person at the constituent Institute of Rehabilitation and Behavioral Sciences, Puducherry campus (or) Admission section of VMRF (Deemed to be University), Salem and utilize the facilities for applying the online Application.
- h) Incomplete online application form will not be accepted.

6) HALL TICKET:

- a) Entrance Examination Hall Ticket can be downloaded from the Entrance Examination application Portal of this University.
- b) Hall Ticket must be produced by the candidates at the time of Entrance Examination centre without fail. No candidate will be allowed to write the Entrance Examination without the Hall Ticket.
- c) Mere acceptance of a person as a candidate for writing the Entrance Examination shall not confer on him/her any right/eligibility for admission. The candidate who does not satisfy the prescribed eligibility criteria shall not be considered for admission.
- d) Candidates will not be allowedto carry any textual material, printed (or) written, bits of papers (or) any prohibited materials such as Pencil, Calculator, Mobile Phone (or) any other Electronic Devices that are likely to be of unfair assistance inside the examination hall. The Pen, Pencil and eraser will be provided to the candidates at the examination hall.
- e) Candidates will not be allowed to leave the examination hall till completion of Entrance Examination.
- f) Candidates shall maintain perfect silence and attend to their papers only. Any conversation (or) gesticulation (or) disturbance in the examination hall will be deemed as misbehavior. If any candidate is found to be misbehaving (or) using unfair means (or) resorting to impersonation, his/her candidature will be cancelled and he/she will be liable to be debarred from taking any Entrance Examination of the Deemed to be University.
- g) The OMR answer sheet of the candidates should be handed over to the invigilator along with the question booklet. If any candidate fails to do so, his/her candidature shall be cancelled.

9) MODE OF SELECTION:

- a) Selection will be made on the basis of the marks secured by the candidates in the All India Entrance Examination. Intimation letter will be sent by E-mail to the candidates provisionally selected for admission.
- b) In case of candidates who secure the same marks in the Entrance Examination, ranking will be made based on their academic performance in the qualifying examination prescribed for admission.
- c) In order to facilitate the above ranking process, candidates should upload their copy of H.Sc. Mark Sheet(s) on (or) before **05.07.2025** (or) submit to the Director (Admissions), VMRF(Deemed to be University), Salemin person (or) by email (or) by Courier, failing which they will lose rank position in the rank list as indicated in sub clause (b) above.
